





Thank you, God, for sending Jesus to earth to be my Friend, Teacher, and Savior.





FOR THE READER

Sometimes we find that our traditions hold to ideas that only sometimes match the biblical text. I have realized this many times in my own study. For example, I grew up learning that Mary was on a donkey, nine months pregnant, hurrying to Bethlehem. I often imagined Mary and Joseph running door to door, looking for a place to have Jesus. When we read the text, this is not the case. Let me explain.

Our biblical text explains that Mary and Joseph were in Bethlehem well before the time of the birth of Jesus. It tells us "While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born... (Luke 2:6).

At times, the word used for inn can confuse us. The translation of the word we use for "inn" is the word (Kataluma) in Greek. It means "upper living area."

This is a different word than what is used when referring to, for example, the inn in the story of the good Samaritan, which is (pandexion in Greek).

Many Bible translations are beginning to refer to it correctly as an upper living area of the cave, like an upstairs bedroom.

The event of the birth of Jesus was very normal, natural, and beautiful, as any birth should be. It was also miraculous! It brings me so much thankfulness and joy when I realize that God allowed his Son to be born in such a simple way. It reflects God drawing near in every way.

Teach your children to read carefully. It will be the most wondrous experience they could ever have.
